Revised Scheme of Delegation 2010

SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS

Attached at Appendix A is the current scheme with the proposed highlighted changes. Key changes to the scheme are as follows:

- Paragraphs 5.5-5.7 The inclusion of specific delegation relating to East Midlands Joint Police Authority Committee (refer to the later agenda item)
- Paragraphs 5.8-5.9 The inclusion of specific delegation relating to the Air Support Unit – member Panel
- Paragraphs 6.4.12-6.4.13 Specific requirements arising from the Standards Committee. The first paragraph being a recommendation previously made to the Police Authority by the committee.

- Paragraph 8.4.5 This has been identified as a specific responsibility currently omitted from the Scheme of Delegation and Terms of Reference for the Human Resources & Professional Standards Committee. Suggested changes to the Terms of Reference are given in Appendix B.
