**Introductions**

PC Silverwood introduced himself as the new Beat Manager for the area and advised residents of his mobile telephone number: 07812 215919 and email address david.silverwood@nottinghamshire.pnn.police.uk

Brief discussion on the venues for the meetings for 2010, residents suggested Harrow Road Community Centre. PCSO Bowe to make enquiries.

**Update on priorities**

PC Silverwood asked residents if they wish to keep the current priorities as listed below. They advised that they would however they would like AntiSocial Behaviour to be considered especially as the students were due to return. PC Silverwood advised residents that Operation Country '09 is due to commence on the 21/09/09 and officers will be working until 2am also working closely with Nottingham University and positive action will be taken towards offenders of ASB. It was agreed that the priorities below would remain in place until the next Local Area Group Meeting.

**Cycling on the Pavement – Derby Road**

PC Silverwood advised that this is an ongoing priority and that the SNT are issuing Fixed Penalty Notices to offenders who are caught cycling on the pavement.

**Drug dealing in the Penn Avenue area**

PC Silverwood advised that this is an ongoing priority as there is still a problem with drugs around the area of Penn Avenue.

### **Dog Fouling**

PC Silverwood advised that due to the Priority Surveys that had been conducted recently in and around the area, this was the biggest problem that needs addressing.

PCSO Bowe advised residents that the problem areas appear to be Sutton Passeys Crescent, Orston Drive and Charnock Avenue.

PC Silverwood advised that efforts would be made to make contact The Woodlands regarding this matter and ask operators to be aware of the problem. Camera 191 is located on Charnock Avenue and covers the area of Orston Drive and surrounding streets.

PC Silverwood also advised that a further dog fouling operation is to be arranged to catch the offenders.

### **Issues from the local community**

A resident advised that graffiti was becoming a problem again in the area.

- CPO Doherty advised he would contact Street Scene to arrange removal.

A resident advised of litter in and around the Queens Medical Centre

- SNT advised this would be passed onto the relevant Beat Team.

Residents advised that the area of Orston Green and Orston Drive is now being used as a short cut for vehicles and motorcycles. They advised that they are exceeding the speed limit and are fearful for pedestrians.

- PC Silverwood advised he would contact Highways to make enquiries regarding speed signs etc. He also advised he would make Roads Policing aware of the problem so as they can patrol also. He urged residents to try and obtain vrm's of the offending vehicles/motorcycles.
- PCSO Bowe advised that should she come across any vehicles causing harassment, alarm or distress she would issue Section 59 notices.
- Dawn Simpson also advised she would contact Highways to arrange the possible erection of signs.

### **Miscellaneous Issues**

PC Silverwood advised residents of the burglary on Sutton Passeys Crescent which occurred on the 13/09/09 and also of the attempted burglary on the same date. He also gave a description of the offender and advised residents to be aware. Crime Prevention advice was also given.

Maya Fletcher advised that the next UNIPOL meeting is due to take place on Monday 21/09/09 at 7.15pm at St Marys Church Wollaton Hall Drive.

Maya Fletcher advised that the next Council Core Strategy meeting is due to take place on 23/11/09 at 6.15pm at St Marys Church Wollaton Hall Drive.
